



2020-2021 Health Requirements for Incoming Grades Kindergarten, 2nd, 6th, or 9th

Students entering kindergarten, sixth, and ninth grades are all required to have a **HEALTH and DENTAL EXAM FORM dated 9/2019 or later** on file at their local school **in addition to up to date IMMUNIZATIONS**.

Below are the 2020-2021 IMMUNIZATION, DENTAL and HEALTH EXAM requirements for all targeted grade levels, at the present time. It is recommended that the Certificate of Health form and required immunizations be completed by the student 's health care provider and **returned to the SCHOOL NURSE prior to the start of school in the fall. PLEASE NOTE THE SCHOOL YOUR CHILD ATTENDS IN THE EMAIL

Kindergarten

- 1) Physical exam dated 9/2019 or later
- 2) Vision Exam
- 3) Dental Exam
- 4) Up to date vaccine record including:
 - a) (4) DPT's and AT LEAST (4) IPV's with the last dose of each being given on or after the 4th bday.
 - b)(2) MMR's given AFTER the first birthday and at least 28 days apart
 - c) (3) Hep B's, with the first 2 doses given at least 2 months apart and the last dose AT LEAST 4 months from the 1st dose
 - d)(2) Varicella given AFTER the first birthday and at least 28 days apart

Second Grade

1) Dental Exam

Sixth Grade

- 1) Physical Exam dated 9/2019 or later
- 2) Up to date vaccine record including:
 - a) All the vaccines listed under
 - "Kindergarten"
 - b) PLUS A dose of Tdap
 - c) PLUS A dose of Meningitis (must be MCV4 given on or after 11th B-day)

Eighth grade for High School

- 1) Physical exam dated 9/2019 or later
 - a) (3) copies are required: 1) Parent 2) Grade School 3) High School Nurse (Grade school medical records do not get to the High school until late October)
 - b) "Certificate of Child Health Exam" will count for both a sports physical and for medical compliance but a "SPORT PHYSICAL" WILL ONLY WORK FOR SPORTS AND WILL NOT MAKE A STUDENT MEDICALLY COMPLIANT FOR THE PHYSICAL EXAM COMPONENT.
- 2) Up to date vaccine record including:
 - a) All vaccines listed under "Kindergarten, and Sixth

Do not give the school the only copy of your medical records. . . . ALWAYS KEEP A COPY FOR YOURSELF!
