Rising Pre-K Cougars



- Stamped United States Post Office change of address form

Registration FAQ

Q: I can't make any of the dates to register in April. Will there be other dates to register?

A: Yes, we will have future dates available on our website soon.

Q: My child has an upcoming doctor's appointment for a new immunization/physical. Can I bring the immunization/physical record that I have?

A: Yes, Please bring your most recent copy and our nurse will be in touch with what else is needed.

Q: Will there be a supply list available so I can start school shopping?

A: Our grade level teams are working hard to update the supply list and will contact you about a Meet and Greet during the summer where you will receive the school supply list.

Q: I just recently moved outside of Canty's attendance boundary, can my child still attend this fall?

A: According to the CPS attendance boundaries for Neighborhood Schools your child will have to reside in our attendance boundary to be eligible for a seat at Canty.

Q: Is Kindergarten a full day program?

A: Yes, Kindergarten is required for children 5 years old and is full day.

Q: Will my child receive a school lunch during the day?

A: Yes, CPS provides free lunch and breakfast for all students. Students can still bring bagged lunch if they prefer. (No fast-food allowed)

Q: Does my child need to wear a school uniform daily?

A: No, There is not a uniform policy at Canty but there is a Gym uniform that ALL students are required to wear during gym. You will be able to purchase online at the start of the school year. We will provide more information at that time.

Q: Does Canty charge a school fee and if so how do I pay it?

A: Canty does have a school fee of \$75.00 every school year. This fee will be added to your students account on Aspen and can be paid through your parent portal.
