# Canty School Local School Council Resolution

## Regarding the Chicago Public Schools Proposed Return to In-Person Learning

Whereas many members of the Canty School community have been devastated by the COVID-19 pandemic. 60634 has lost 108 lives to the COVID-19 virus since March of 2020, and several families in the Canty community have lost loved ones and are grieving, and

Whereas the Chicago Public Schools proposed reopening plan has not considered the voices of teachers and parents who have expressed concerns over poor ventilation, PPE support, instructional method and

Whereas Canty School has a well-documented history over the years of having a poorly maintained ventilation system, as well as heating and air conditioning control, and

Whereas as reports indicate that poorly maintained ventilation system could possibly spread the COVID-19 virus, and

Whereas outbreaks in schools may well lead to additional chains of infection in the Dunning community which has already been struck by the COVID-19 pandemic currently resulting in a 13.2% positivity rate as of 12/26/20, and

Whereas we fear that the Chicago Public Schools reopening plan may make quality instruction for students who continue with remote learning as well as those who choose in-person learning more difficult given that teachers will have to simultaneously manage a classroom and teach online to students at home, and

Whereas this year has been one of trauma, instability and mourning for many of our students who need consistency rather than interruption to the routines they are finally getting accustomed to.

Be it therefore resolved that the Local School Council of Canty School urge the Chicago Public School leadership and the Chicago Board of Education to reconsider their proposed reopening plans and that students remain remote until a safe return to learning plan is developed in collaboration with members of the community including families, teachers and staff, and school administration.

Be it further resolved that a copy of this resolution be forwarded on to Dr. Janice Jackson, CEO of Chicago Public Schools, all members of the Chicago Board of Education and Alderman Nicholas Sposato of the 38<sup>th</sup> Ward for the Area served by Canty School.
